Religious Education; GOD AMONG US
FOCUS QUESTION;

How is God revealed to the world through the Trinity?

OUTCOME;

By the end of this unit, students will be able to outline the various ways in which God has been revealed to the world throughout history and in the present day.

English

English will comprise of a Literacy block. During this time students will participate in sustained reading and writing and reflect on an inquiry focus. They will engage in teacher-student reading and writing conferences. The Accelerated Reader program will continue to be implemented across Year 6.
